

# Input Integration Module (IIM)

## Universal Input Expander

The Input Integration Module (IIM) is an universal input module designed to accept voltage inputs from various products. The IIM is used with the Event Management Controller and can be daisy chained to increase the number of inputs on a system. The unit also has four outputs that can be used to drive small or large currents. High fault tolerance and protection have been at the forefront of the design and the small footprint of the board makes it an easy choice for installers and integrators alike. The board has been extremely well designed and can fit behind a wall plate and is roughly the size of a matchbox.


